**CANCELLATION POLICY**

---

Cancellations on Transient Camping must be made with a minimum of 24 hours notice. Otherwise, the camper will be refunded the amount paid LESS one night camping plus the reservation fee.

---

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

---

For your protection and to ensure everyone’s enjoyment please note and follow the regulations listed below. Please read and conform to all posted signs, regulations, and your campsite permit.

1. Maximum speed limit within the property is 15 km/hr.
2. Camping permits must be displayed on the dashboard of your vehicle and campsite post.
3. Campsites are designed for a maximum of one tent or one trailer only, plus a dining tent.
4. Maximum of 6 overnight campers allowed on one site.
5. One car is permitted on your site; others must be left at visitor parking.
6. Alcoholic beverages are permitted on your campsite only. Note: there is a **total alcohol ban during the Victoria Day weekend.**
7. Quiet time is from 11:00 p.m. until 8:00 a.m.; no excessive noise is allowed at any time.
8. Visitors are permitted from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. No visitors will be allowed in after 9:00 p.m. Registered

campsite permit holders are responsible for the actions and safety of all individuals on their site.

9. No abusive or insulting language, nor threatening behaviour by campers or their pets will be tolerated.
10. Pets must be kept on a 2-metre leash and controlled at all times, plus you must "Stoop and Scoop". Pets are not allowed in the swimming area and/or in any building.
11. Help us keep the campground clean. Please dispose of garbage and litter in bags provided and place in garbage bin in service area.
12. Sewage dumping stations are provided for your use. All sewage must be contained within your camping unit.
13. Due to electrical demand on individual sites the use of air conditioners is only allowed on 30 amp-serviced sites.
14. No dirt bikes, ATVs, or mini-bikes allowed.
15. No riding bicycles after dark unless equipped with a light.
16. No motorized boats are allowed on Springwater Pond.
17. The beach area closes at 8:30 p.m.
18. Campsites must be cleaned before check out time at 2:00 p.m. If you wish to extend your permit, please do so prior to 12 noon.
19. In addition to all regulations noted above, Conservation Areas Regulations, Section 29, Regulation 100 under the Conservation Authorities Act also apply.

### GENERAL INFORMATION

---

- Phones** Pay telephones are located behind the old Gatehouse and near the comfort station in Poplar Hill.
- Firewood** Campers are prohibited from transporting firewood into the Conservation Area. Firewood is available for purchase at the Gatehouse store.
- Washrooms** Along with the several vault type toilets, which are located throughout the Area, there are also four facilities, which have hot/cold running water and showers.
- Laundry** Located within the area of White's Mill and Pine Ridge washrooms.
- Sewage** Dumping stations for trailer septic systems are located near the comfort stations in Poplar Hill, Pineridge, Spruce Woods, and White's Mill.
- Garbage** A depot is located west of the King Fisher camping area. Garbage bags are provided to campers upon arrival. Please deposit all refuse in the provided bins at the depot, there is no collection directly from the campsites.
- Recycling** A depot is located west of the King Fisher camping area. Recycling bags are provided to campers upon arrival. Glass, plastic containers (1&2), pop cans and newspaper are acceptable recycling materials. There is a spent propane cylinder-recycling depot in this area.
