SEASONAL SITE FEES

Rates have now been set for the 2012 camping season. We are pleased to report a slightly lower Site Fee increase for 2012 (approximately 2%, which is down from a 3% increase in 2011).

Please remember, a minimum **\$50.00 deposit is due by January 15, 2012**, to hold your site for the 2012 camping season.

Trailer Installation/Relocation	\$ 50.00
External Refrigerator (Energy Star)	\$ 50.00
External Refrigerator (All Others)	\$100.00
