FROM THE CATFISH CREEK CONSERVATION AUTHORITY

RATES HAVE NOW BEEN SET FOR THE 2008 CAMPING SEASON, and we know you have been anticipating the results. We are pleased to report a slightly lower Site Fee increase for 2008 (approximately 4%, which is down from a 7% increase in 2007).

It has become clear that not many people are reading this newsletter. It does serve as a reminder for various details and answers many of your questions. SEASONAL CAMPING FEES

15 amp.: \$1,450.00

30 amp.: \$1,550.00

\$ A minimum \$50.00 deposit is due by January 15, 2008, to hold your site for the 2008 camping season. (This amount will be deducted from your 2008 seasonal site fees)

👉 **Site Fees are due in Full by May 9, 2008 (this is the opening day for Seasonal Camping)**

* An Administration Fee of \$50.00 will be added if fees are not paid in full by **May 19, 2008**.

📝 **Please Remember:** "If the minimum 1 month retail serviced camping has been paid, but less than the full seasonal fee has been paid by June 15th, the camper will no longer be considered "Seasonal" and will be charged the retail camping rate."

WINTER STORAGE

If you will not be camping at Springwater for the 2008 season, and your trailer is being stored on site, the site must be vacated by **April 30, 2008**.

Please Remember Regulation 17: The main campground gate entrance will be locked on the second last Saturday in October and reopen on May 1st. **Any person(s) entering the campground without permission may be charged with trespassing.**
