WINTER STORAGE

If you will not be camping at Springwater this season and your trailer is being stored on site, the site must be vacated by **April 30, 2009**. Please contact the office when you are coming to remove the contents from your site.

Site Deposit: Minimum \$50.00 due January 15, 2009

⌚ Seasonal Camping Fees are **due in FULL by opening day, Friday, May 8th**. An Administration Fee of \$50.00 will be added if fees are not paid in full by May 24, 2009.

"If the minimum 1 month retail serviced camping has been paid, but less than the full seasonal fee has been paid by June 15th, the camper will no longer be considered "Seasonal" and will be charged the retail camping rate."
