



Conservation Area Regulations and Fines

Our Conservation and Natural Areas are regulated under the Conservation Authorities Act (R.R.O. 1990, Regulation 110). Violation of the regulations can result in fines and/or eviction. More information here: https://www.ontario.ca/laws/regulation/900110

The following chart shows the fines which apply to specific offences, and the reasons for prohibiting these activities.
