CATFISH CREEK CONSERVATION AUTHORITY AND COVID-19

Throughout the past number of days the Catfish Creek Conservation Authority (CCCA) has been monitoring the COVID-19 situation. At this time, the Public Health Agency of Canada (PHAC) has assessed the public health risk associated with COVID-19 as **low** for the general population. Based on local, provincial, and national health organization's recommendations, the CCCA has made the difficult decision to cancel the remainder of the 2020 Springwater Maple Syrup Festival.

At this time, the Catfish Creek Conservation Authority will continue to remain open with modified services. The CCCA staff will continue to sell maple syrup products out of the Administration Office. Hand sanitizer and hand washing facilities are provided for our staff and customers.
