
Spingwater Conservation Area Updates

Transient overnight camping begins June 19th, 2020 (Father's Day Weekend).







As of June 19th, 2020 showers will be open.




Campsites are limited to a maximum of six (6) occupants.




As of Friday June 12th, 2020 visitors to campsites will be allowed with Day Pass (\$10.00/vehicle).




All campers must comply with the social distancing of 2 metres when off their campsite or with people from outside of their household.




As of June 19th, 2020 select horseshoe pits will be opened. This is to ensure continued social distancing.








The beach and swimming will be open when clearance has been given by Southwestern Public Health.
