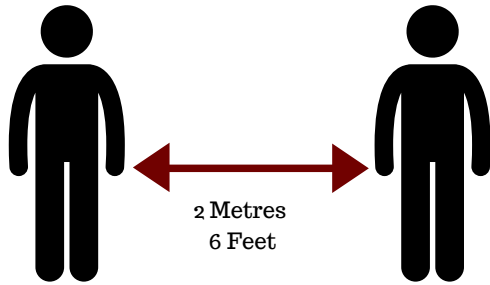

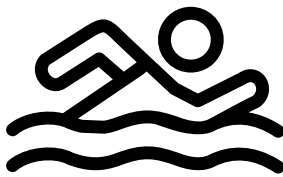
Spingwater Conservation Area Updates



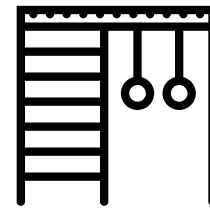
All campers must comply with the social distancing of 2 metres when off their campsite or with people from outside of their household.



Select horseshoe pits & other recreational opportunities will be open. Please continue to social distance.



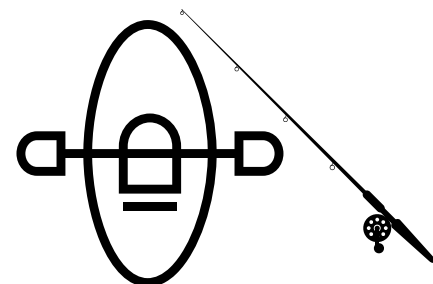
The beach and swimming will be open unless otherwise posted.

Canoe, Kayak and Fishing Pole rentals will not be offered this year. You are welcome to bring your own! Day Pass required (\$10.00/vehicle)

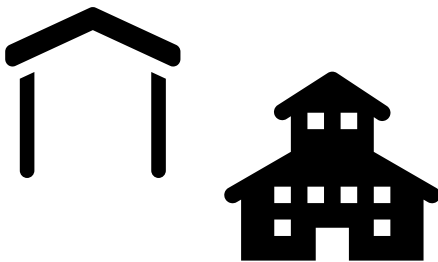
Spingwater Conservation Area Updates CONTINUED

*permitted on a case by case basis

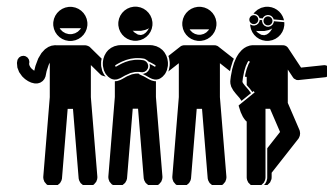


Campsites are limited to a maximum of six (6) occupants.
