Working at a summer camp is both a demanding and rewarding job. LITs will be subjected to a challenging environment that will provide opportunities to become a better leader, work better with their peers and demonstrate positive role modelling to our younger campers. LITs will learn how to set and achieve personal and group goals, as well as enhance their knowledge of group dynamics, safety management, communication, decision-making, and counseling and instructing. Led by the Camp Director, LITs will be supported and motivated by experienced staff with regular feedback culminating in a formal evaluation at the end of the session.
